Dear Scholarship Applicant:

The Mat-Su Chapter of the Alaska Peace Officers Association is an organization made up of local, state, and federal law enforcement officers. To contribute to the continued improvement of our profession and the community we serve, we are offering competitive academic scholarships to Mat-Su area students.

We will award up to three \$1000 scholarships to full-time students from the Mat-Su Valley. Previous recipients may apply but are not accorded an advantage in the selection process. Students from the Mat-Su Valley attending schools inside or outside of Alaska are equally eligible.

The Scholarship Committee will consider the following criteria when selecting recipients:

1. Information submitted on a completed Scholarship Application Form
2. Current Academic Grade Point Average
3. Full-time enrollment at a college or university (with preference given to Criminal Justice, Law, or a related field of study). You may apply before being accepted to a college, but scholarship awards will only be sent to a college or university's financial aid office.
4. Possible in-person or telephone interview with member(s) of the Scholarship Committee.
5. References provided by each student.

You may apply for this scholarship by submitting a completed application and a copy of your most recent high school or college transcripts to:

Transcripts may be mailed separately. However, an application that does not include a copy of the student's most recent transcript will not be considered. If you have attended college full-time for a year or more, it is not necessary to submit your high school transcript.
