Scholarship Applicant:

The Anchorage Chapter of the Alaska Peace Officers Association is an organization made up of local, state, and federal law enforcement officers. To contribute to the continuing improvement of our profession and the community at large, we are offering scholarships for Anchorage area students.

We are awarding scholarships to **full time students** who reside in the Municipality of Anchorage, or family members of an Anchorage Chapter APOA member. Last year five eligible students were awarded a scholarship for the Fall Semester 2019 / Spring Semester 2020. Students from Anchorage attending schools inside or outside of Alaska are eligible.

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate the following:

1. Completed Scholarship Application Form.
2. Grade Point Average.
3. **Full time enrollment** at an accredited college or university is required. Preference shall be given to Criminal Justice or related field. You may apply before being accepted to a college, but scholarship awards are made to the school's financial aid office.
4. Possible interview of applicant with Scholarship Committee.
5. The endorsement of the applicant's references.
6. Financial need.

You may apply for the scholarship by mailing the completed application, a copy of your most recent high school or college transcripts, and letter or proof of acceptance (if you have attended college full time for a year or more, it is not necessary to obtain your high school transcript) to:
